3.3 Study Site

The Ledzokuku-Krowor Municipality is one of the districts of the Greater Accra region carved out of Kpeshie sub-metro (Ghana Statistical Service (GSS), 2014). It is bounded by the La-Dade Kotopon, Adentan and Tema Metropolis to the West, North and East respectively. The Southern boundary of the Municipality is the Gulf of Guinea. The Municipality has an estimated population of 273,743 (projection from 2010 census). It forms about a fifth of the total population in the region and grows at an estimated 4.4% annual growth rate.
