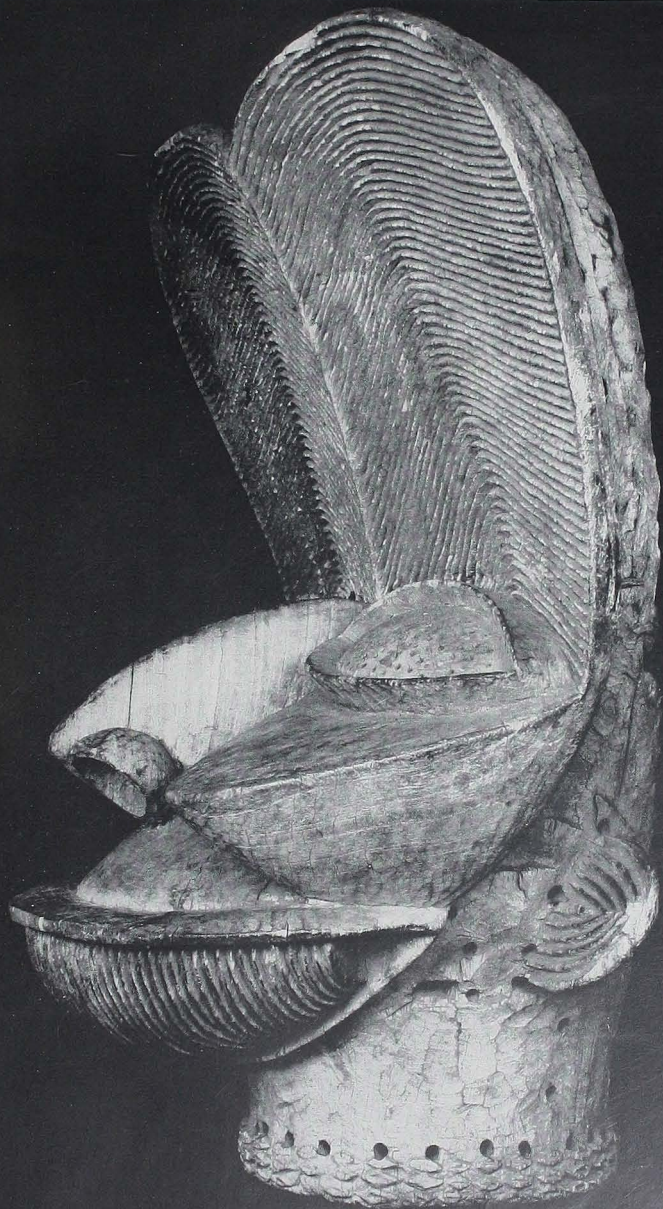

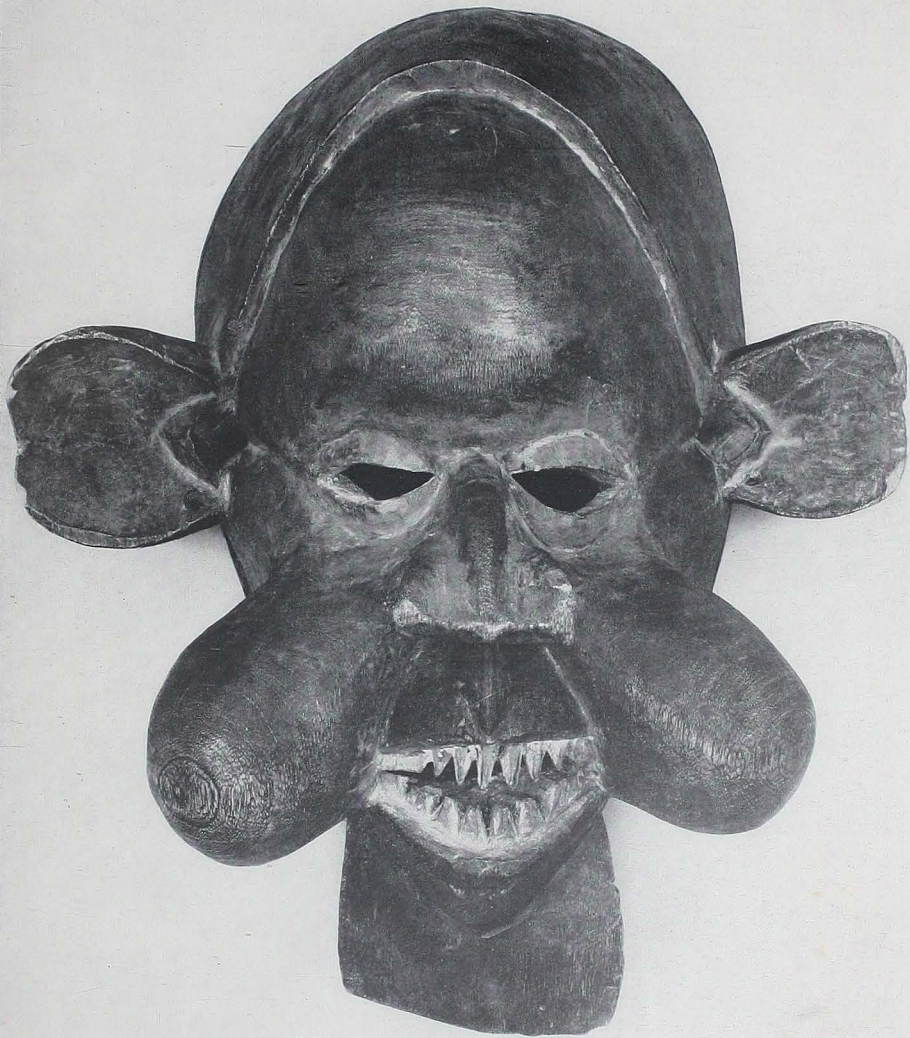

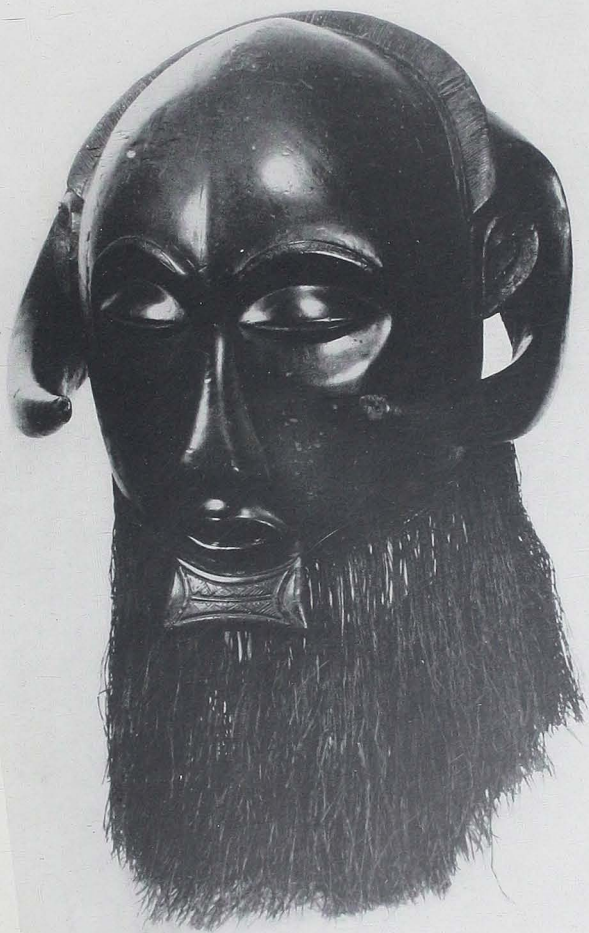

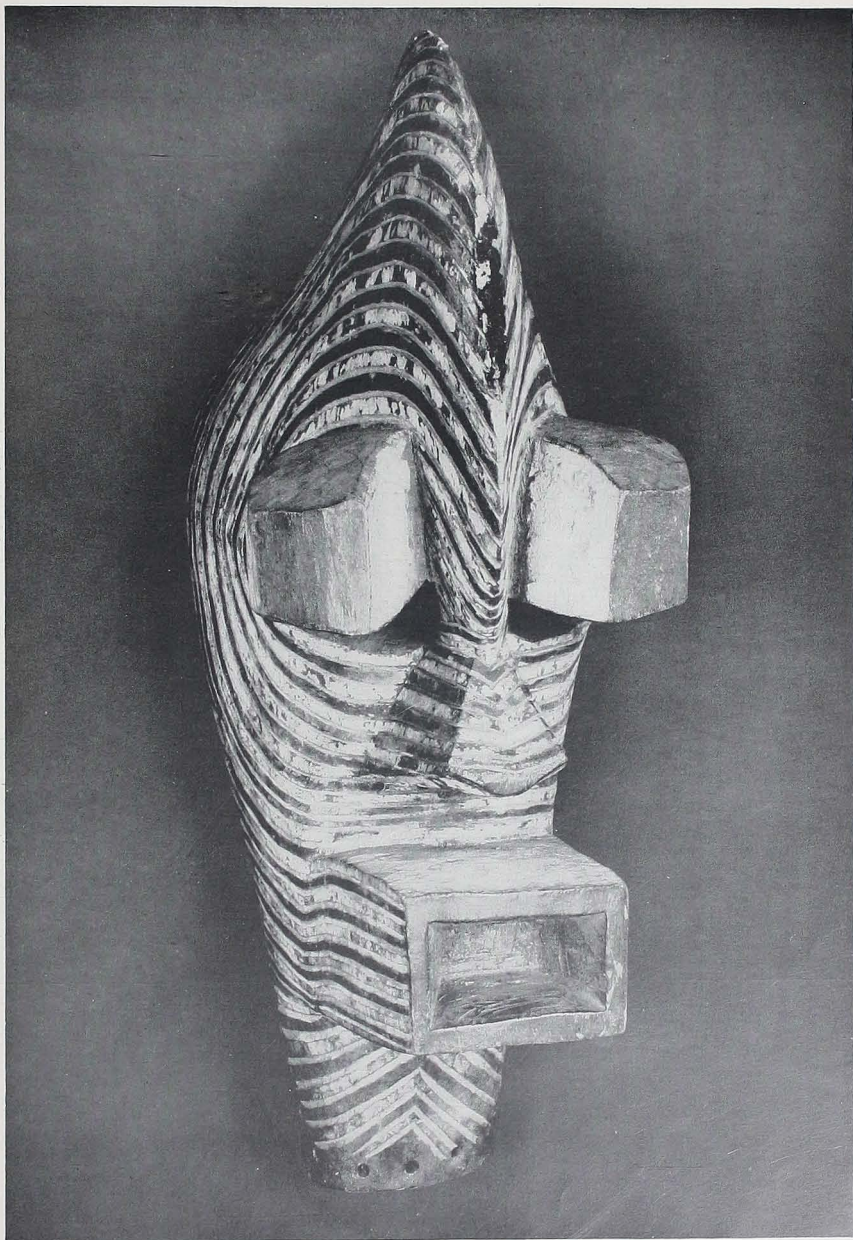

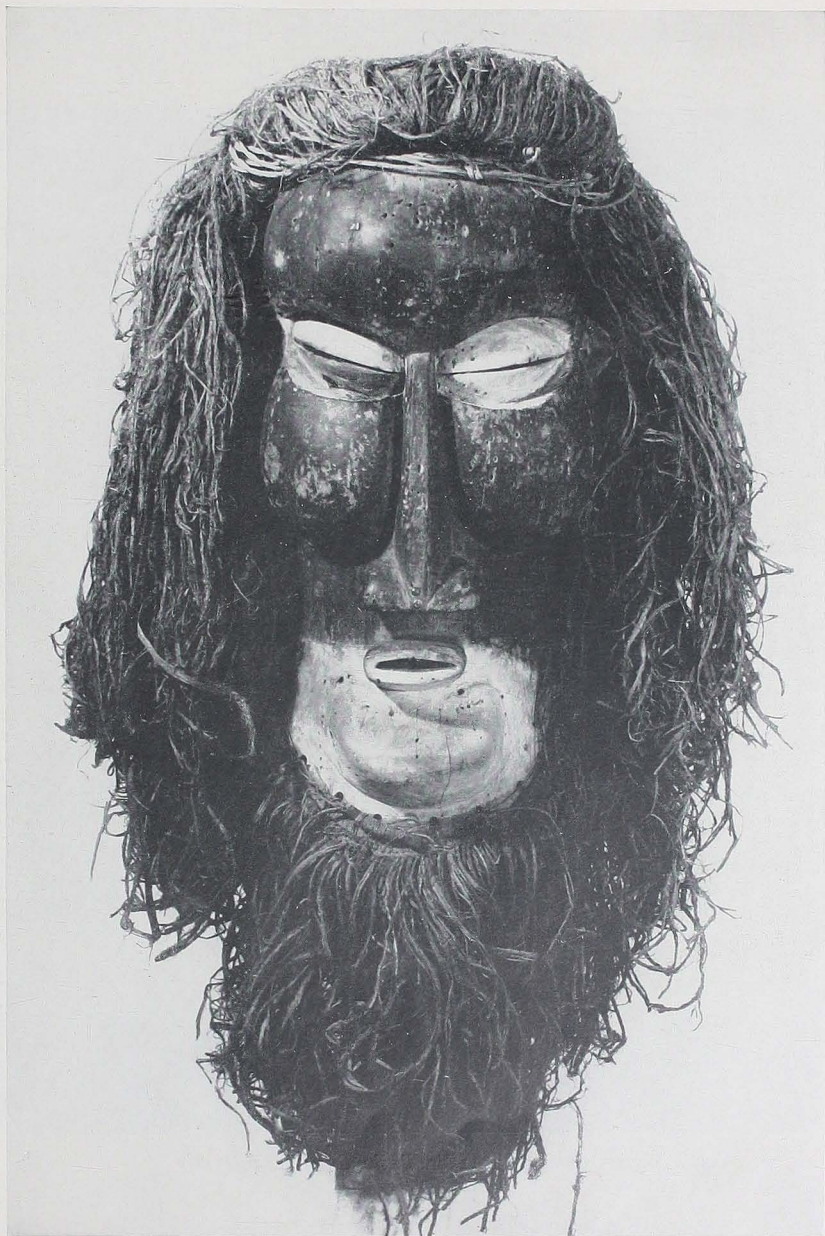

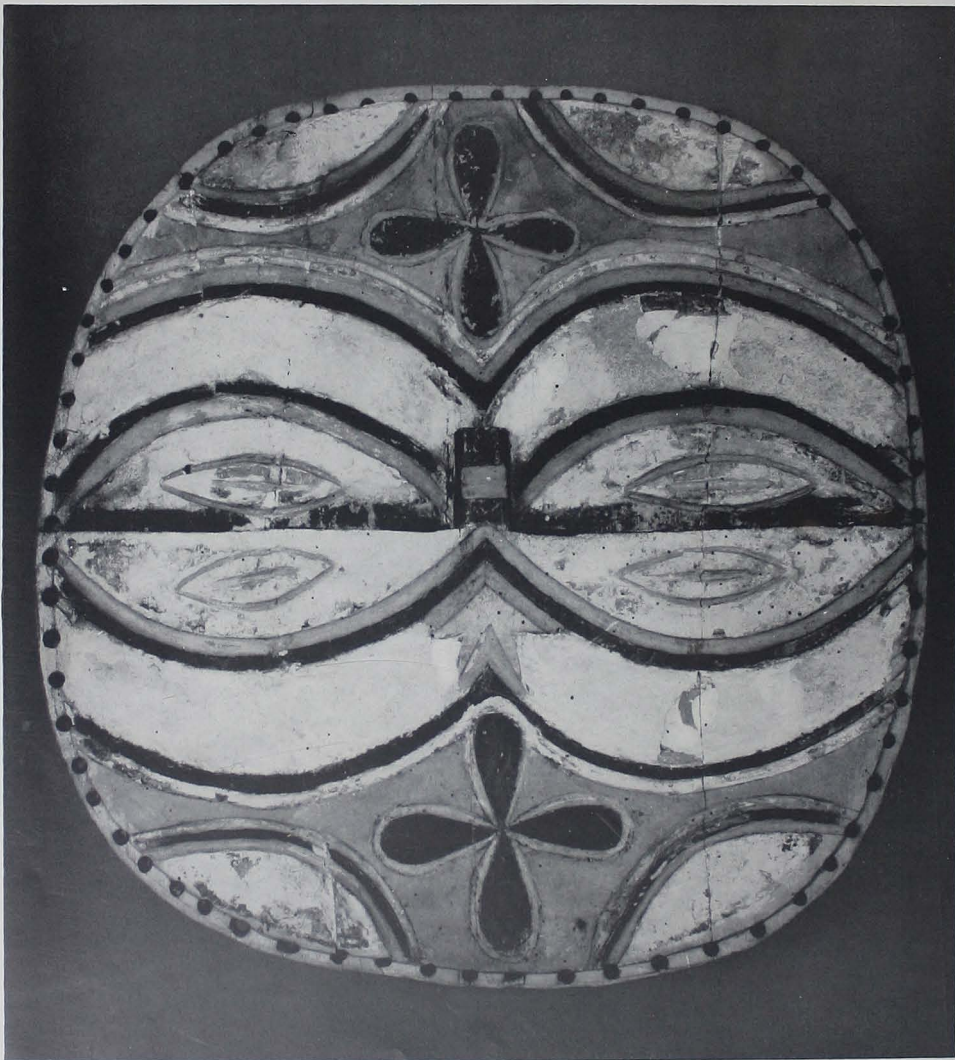


27. MASK. Polychrome wood and raffia, h. 12 in. *Bayaka, Congo (Leopoldville)*

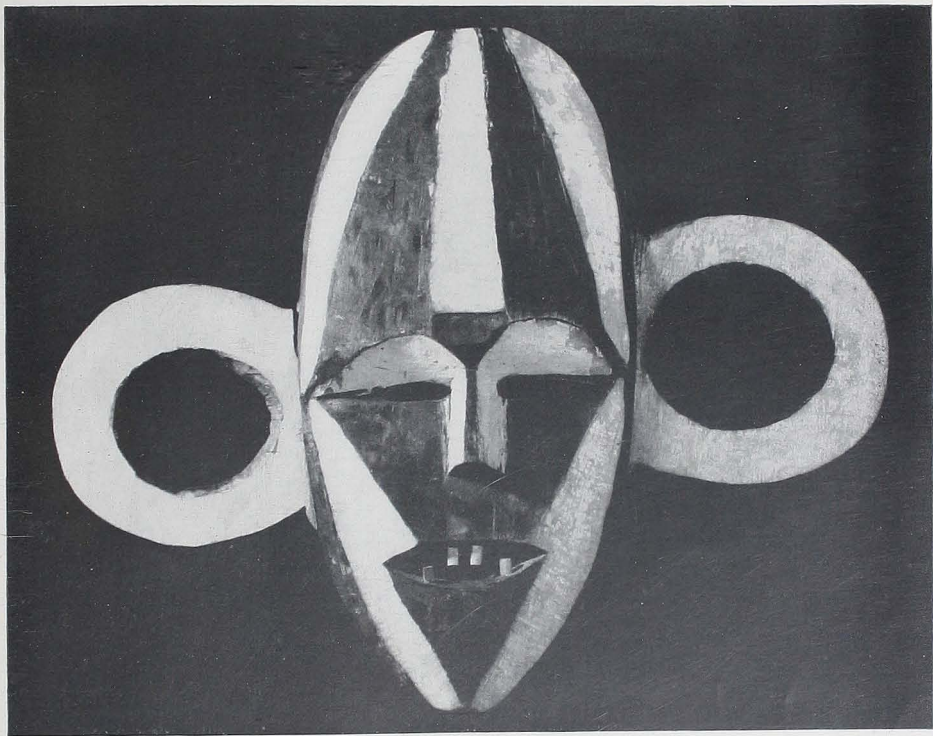

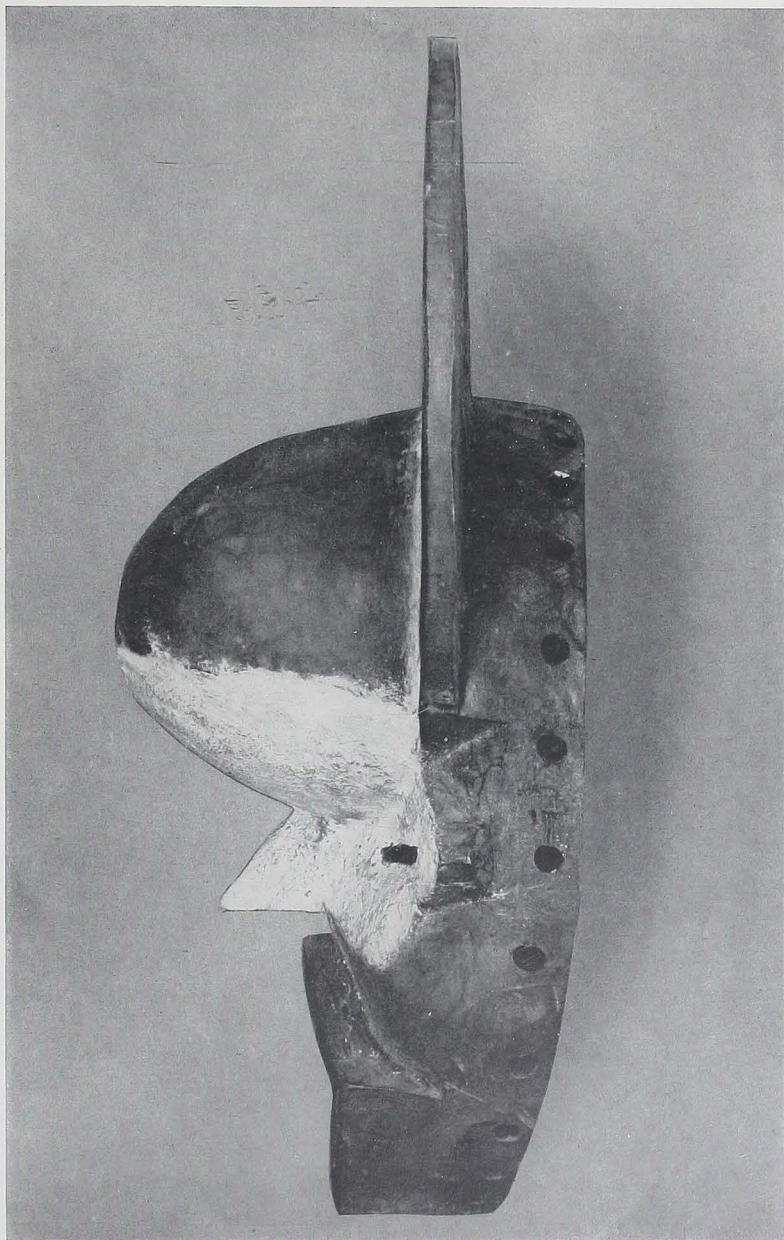

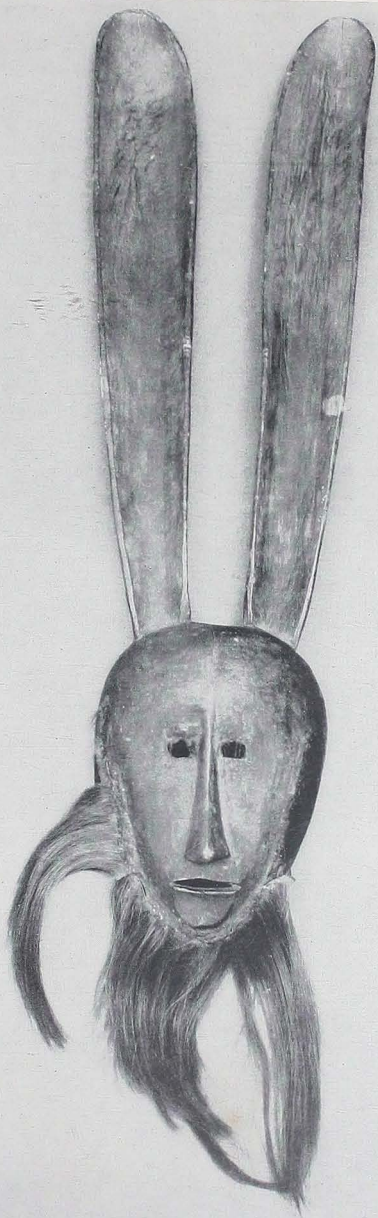

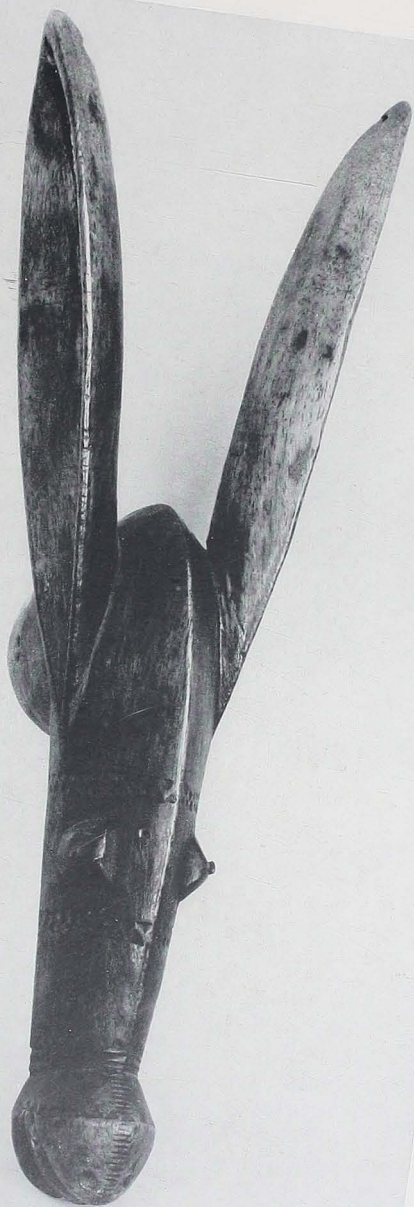

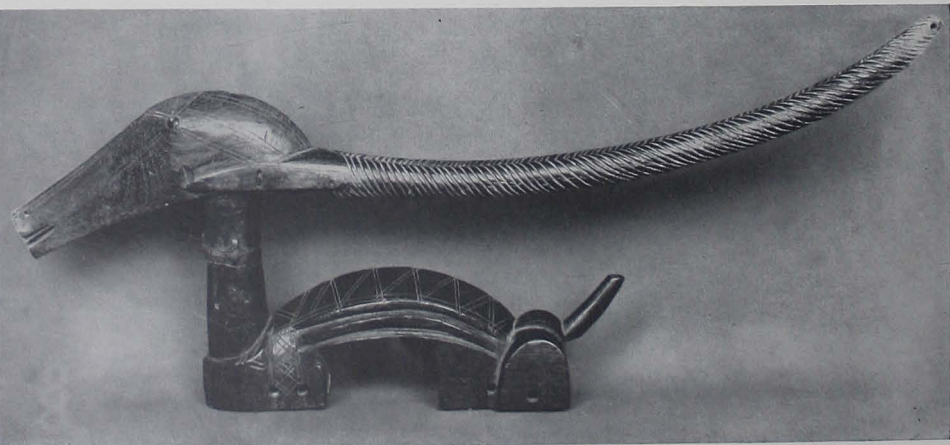

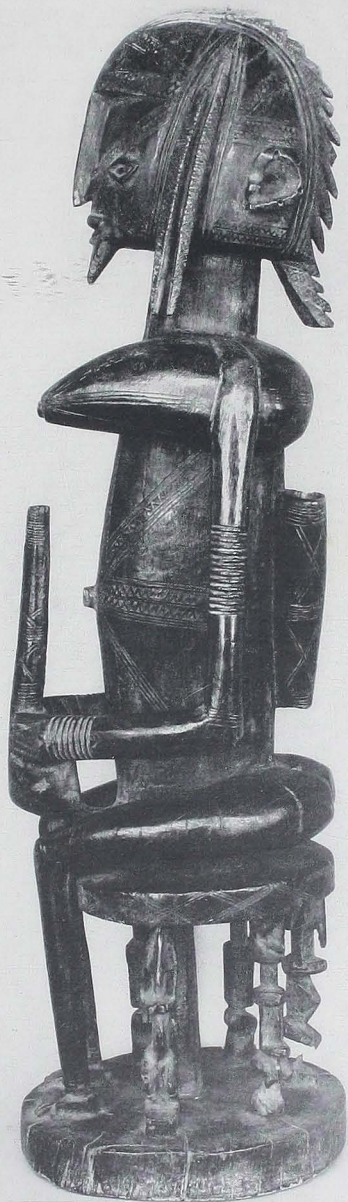

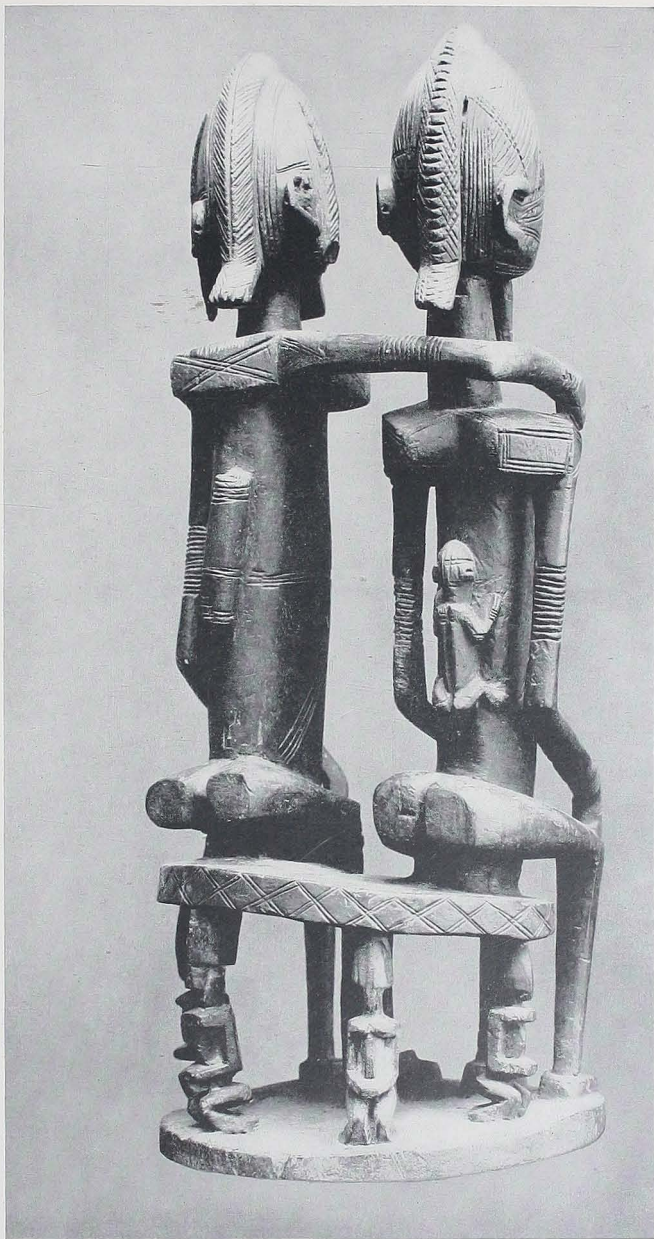

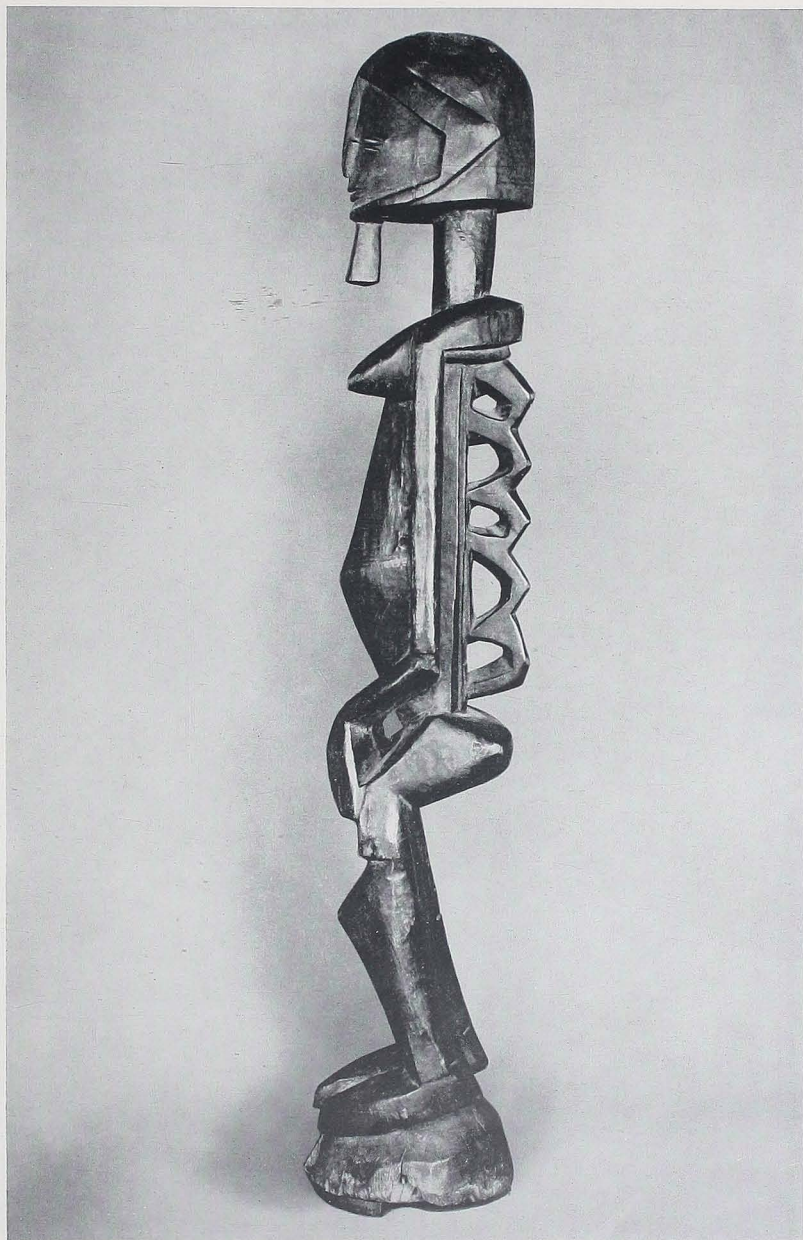

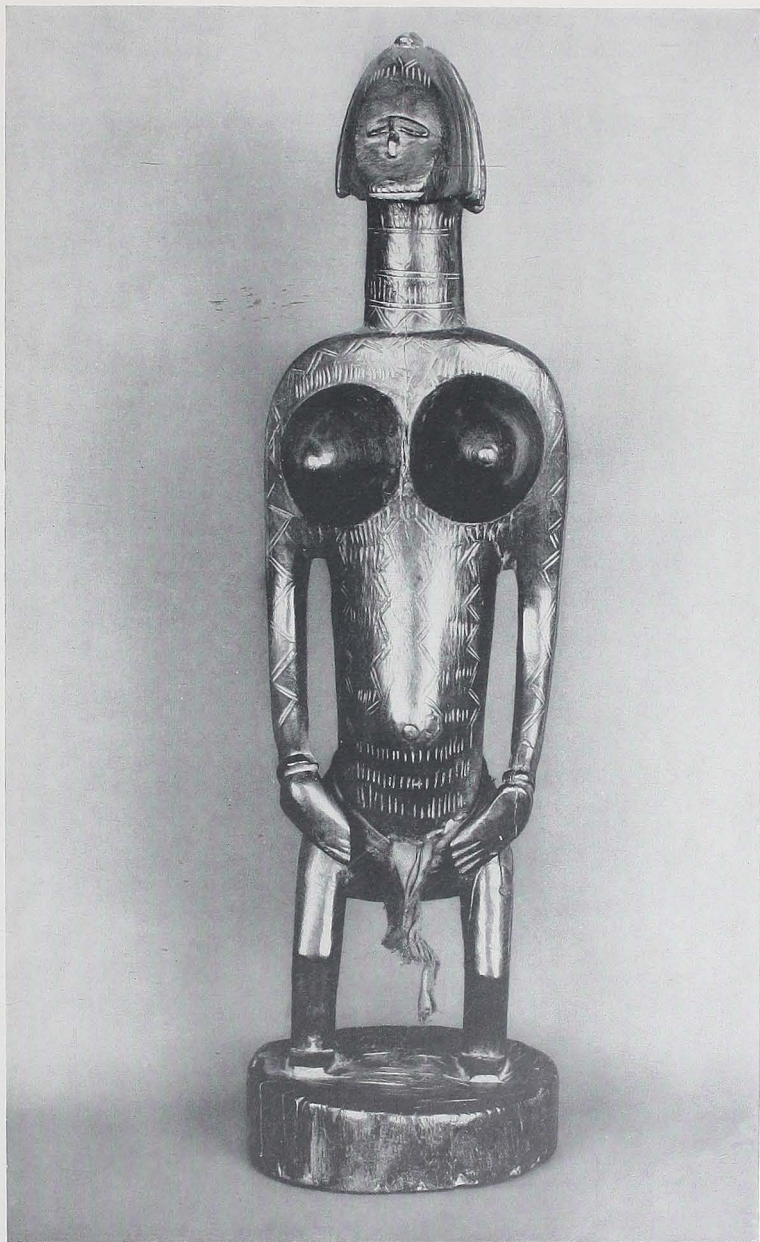

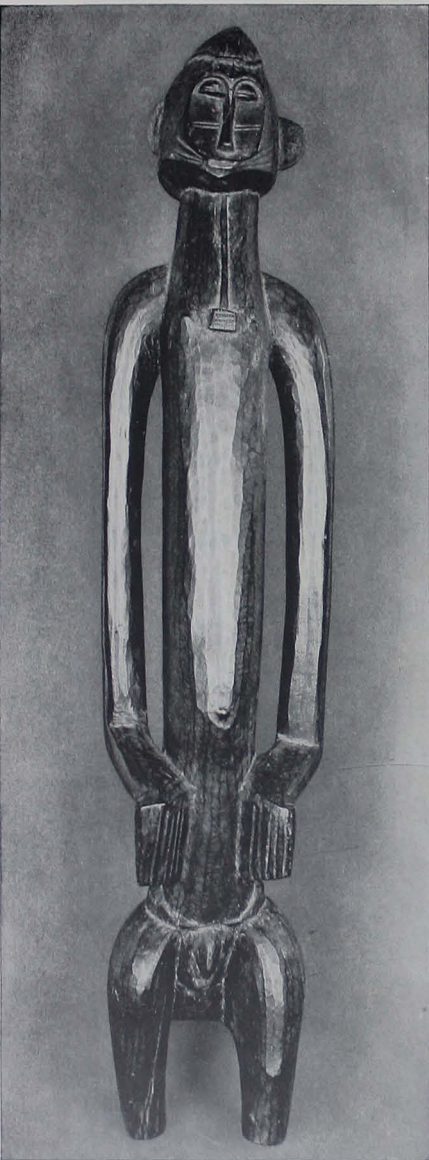

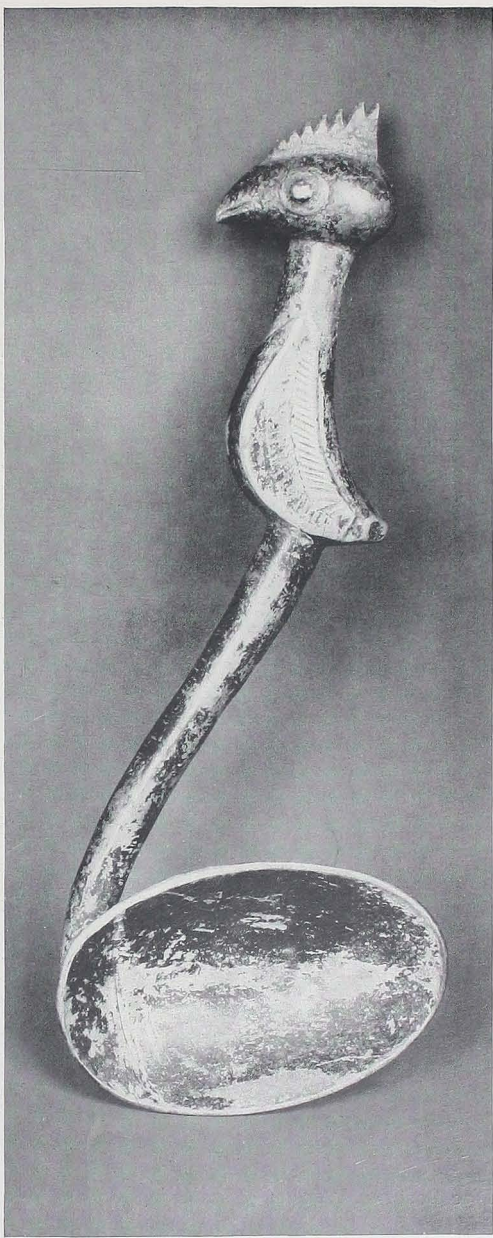
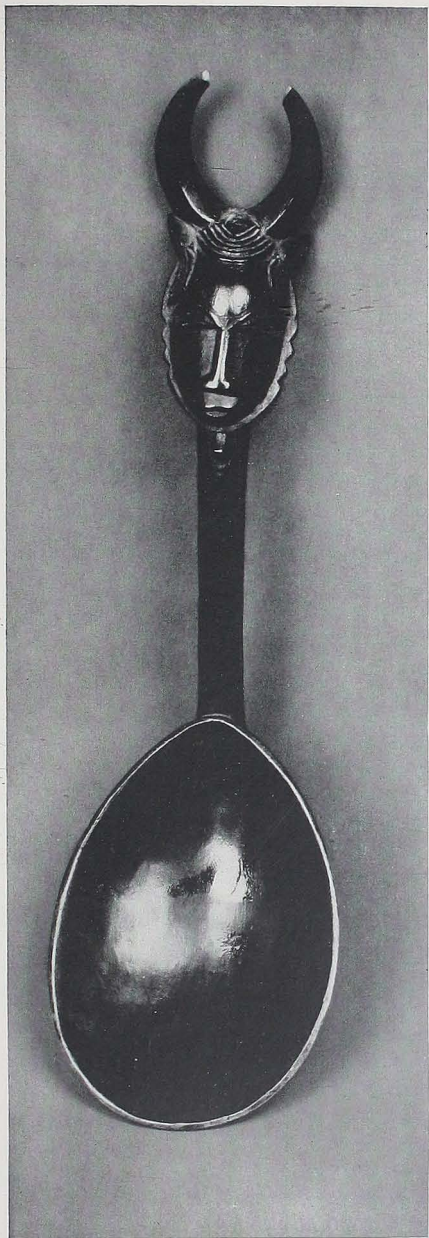

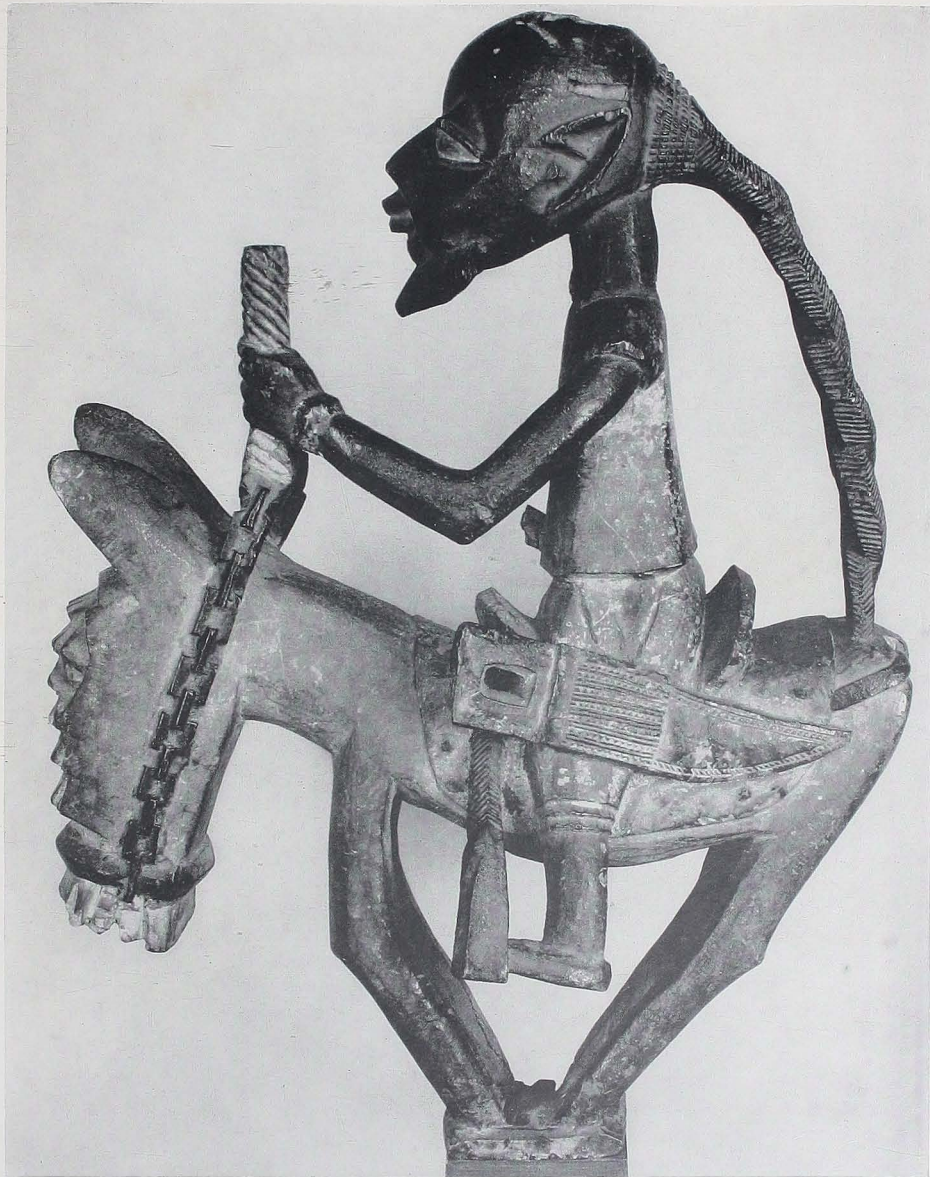

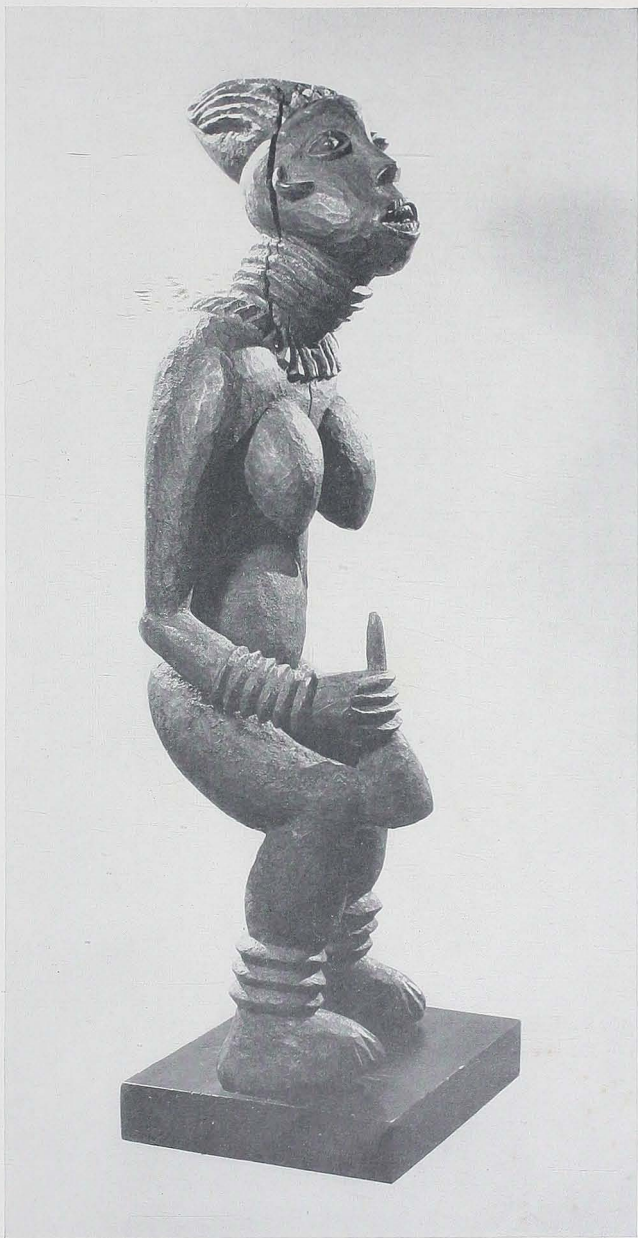

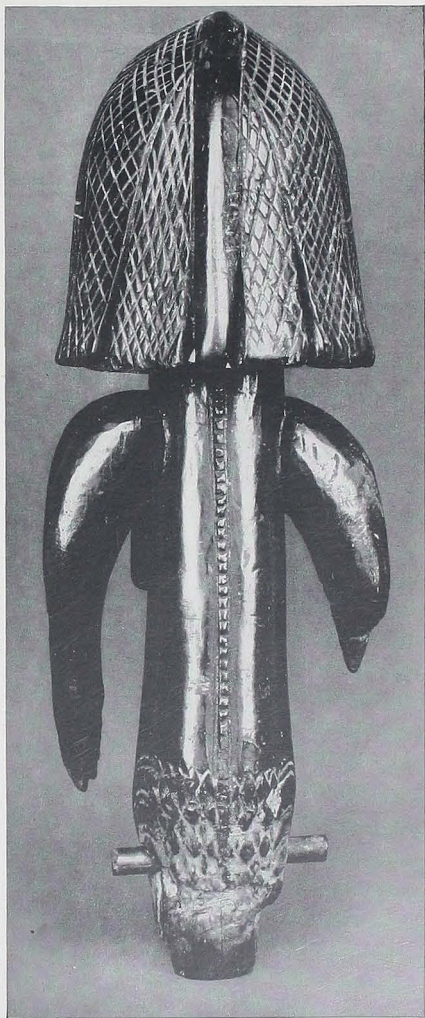

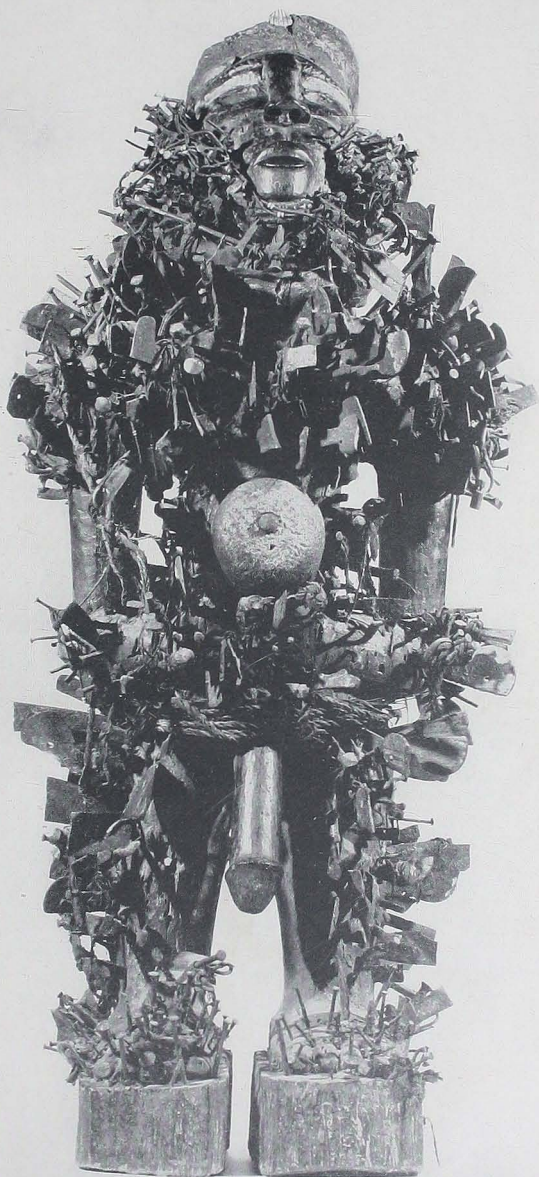

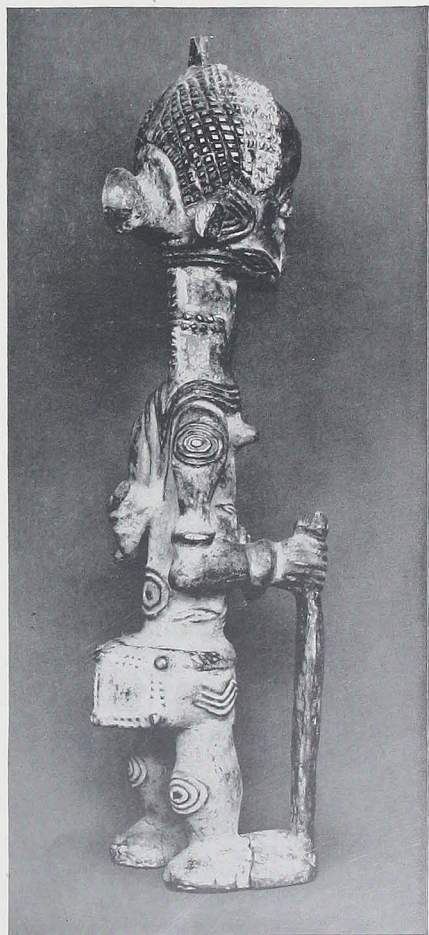

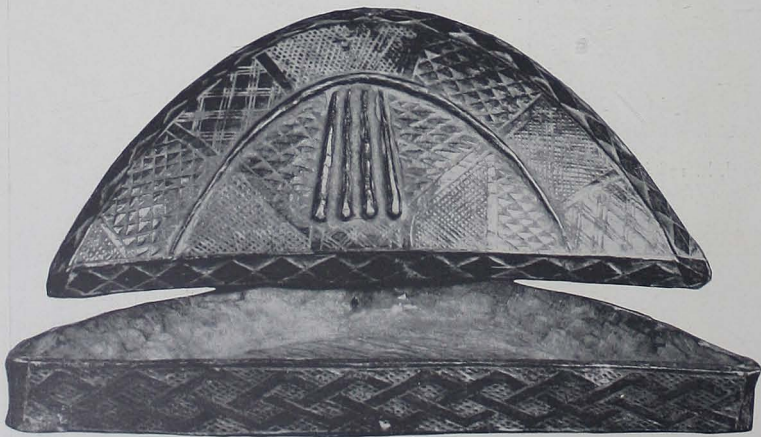

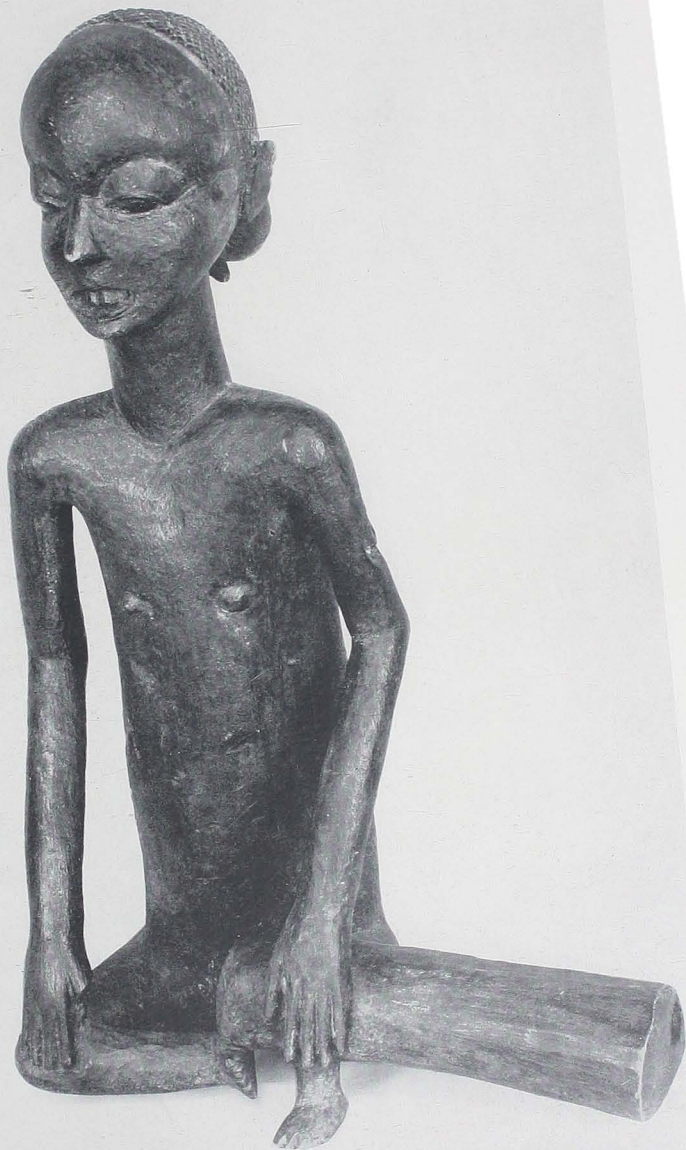

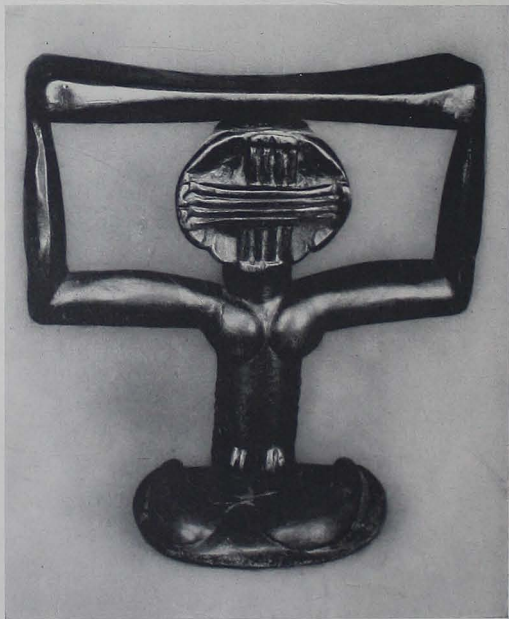

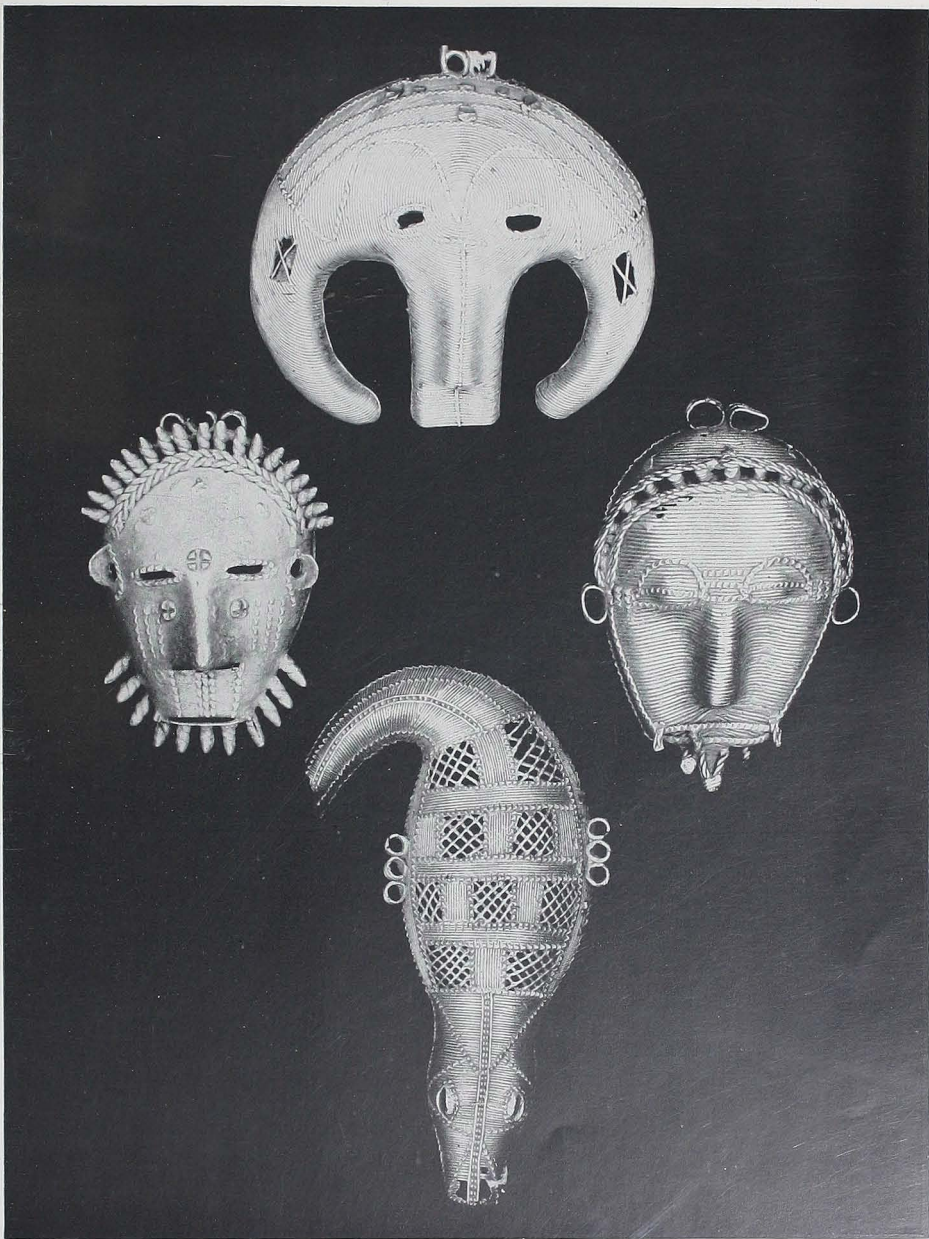

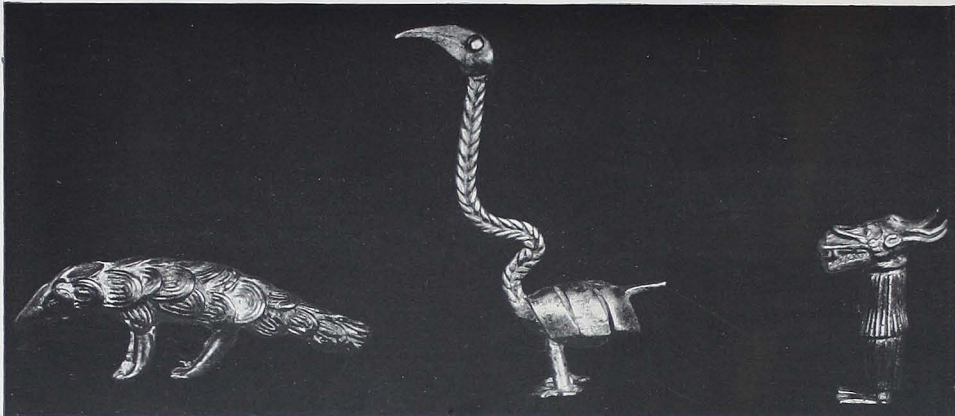

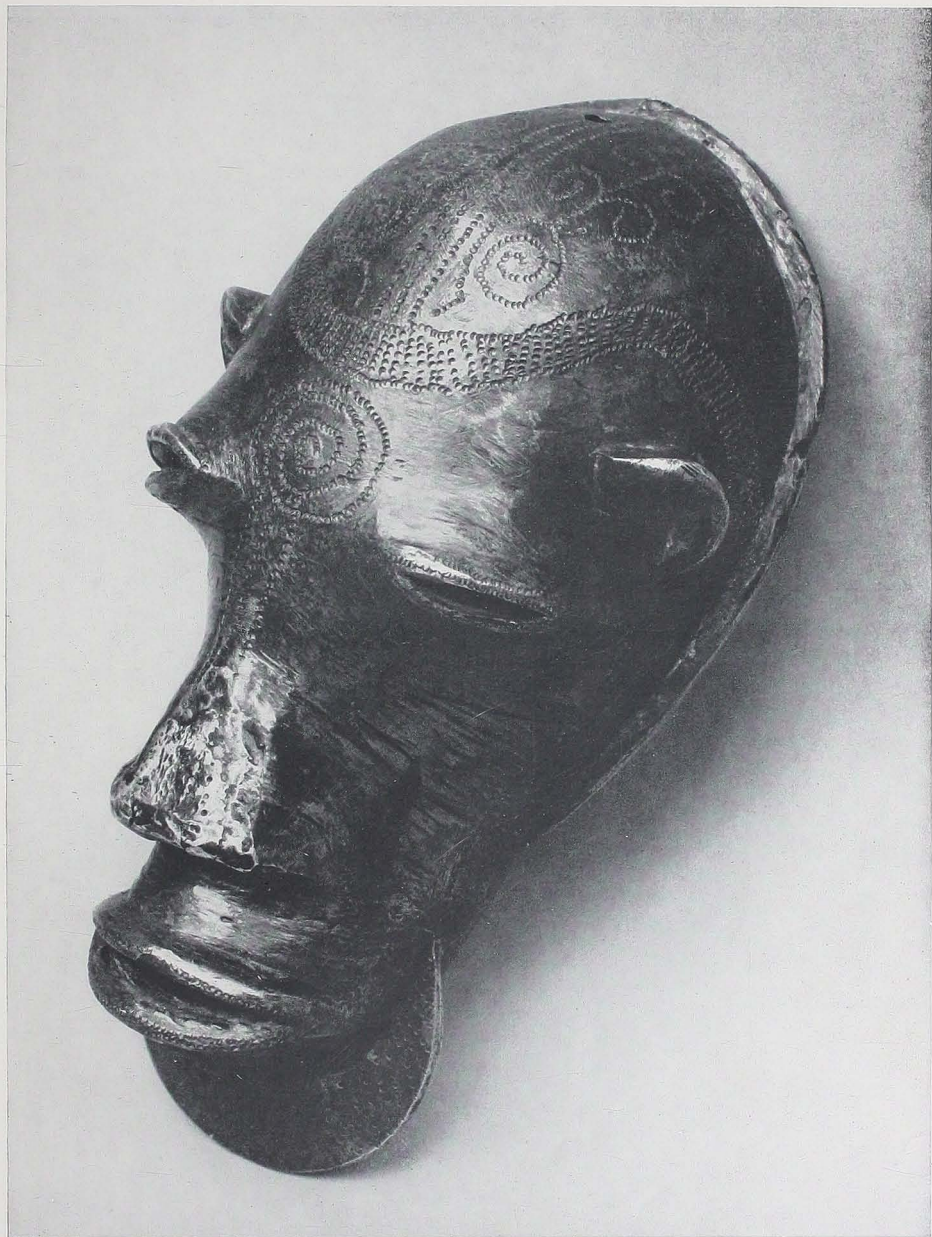
