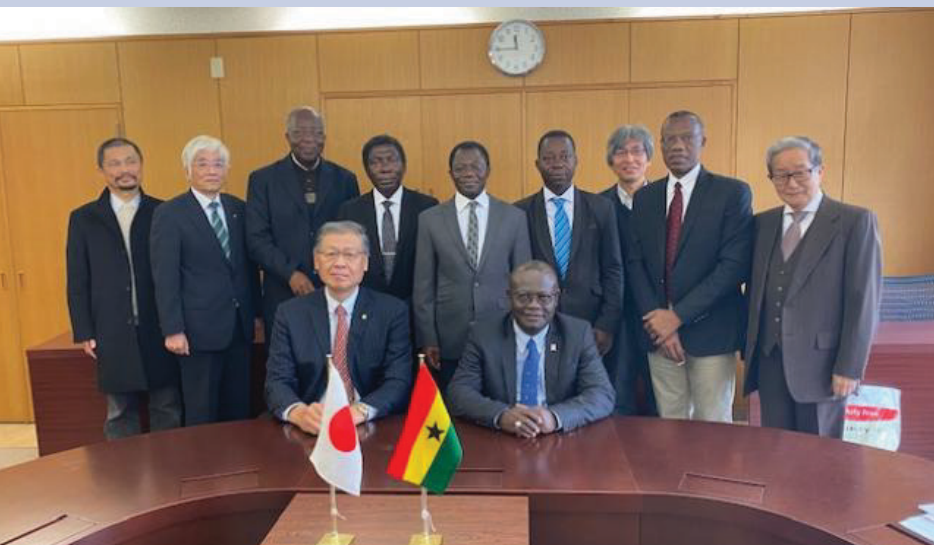
Academic Quality Assurance Unit (AQAU) Collaborates with Ghana School of Law
